Without a deeper understanding of how primate reproduction is regulated, and without the control over human population that such an understanding can bring, the quality of life for all primate species may well become substantially diminished.

Consequently, we dedicate these symposia to the thesis that a deeper understanding of primate reproductive biology will ultimately improve all
