Fruits of Perseverance - Guillaume Teasdale

Founded by French military entrepreneur Antoine Laumet de Lamothe Cadillac in 1701, colonial Detroit was occupied by thousands of French settlers who established deep roots on both sides of the river. The city's unmistakable French past, however, has been long neglected in the historiography of New France and French North America. Exploring the French colonial presence in Detroit, from its establishment to its

dissolution in the early nineteenth century, *Fruits of Perseverance* explains how a society similar to the rural settlements of the Saint Lawrence valley developed in an isolated place and how it survived well beyond the fall of New France. The STICS crop model has been developed since

1996 at INRA in collaboration with other research and technical institutes. The Shadow of Dante in French Renaissance Lyric - Alison Baird Lovell 2020-11-09

This book presents an interpretation of Maurice Scève's lyric sequence *Délie*, *objet de plus haute vertu* (Lyon, 1544) in literary relation to the *Vita nuova*, *Commedia*, and other works of Dante Alighieri. Dante's subtle influence on Scève is elucidated in depth for the first time, augmenting the allusions in *Délie* to the *Canzoniere* of Petrarch (Francesco Petrarca). Scève's sequence of dense, epigrammatic dizains is considered to be an early example, prior to the *Pléiade* poets, of French Renaissance imitation of Petrarch's vernacular poetry, in a time when *imitatio* was an established literary practice, signifying the poet's participation in a tradition. While the *Canzoniere* is an important source for Scève's *Délie*, both works are part of a poetic lineage that includes Occitan troubadours, Guinizzelli, Cavalcanti, and Dante. The book

situates Dante as a relevant predecessor and source for Scève, and examines anew the Petrarchan label for Délie. Compelling poetic affinities emerge between Dante and Scève that do not correlate with Petrarch.
